Purpose:

The following outlines the Shelbyville Fire Department's policy for smoking and dipping during training, alarms, in general, and all other activities.

Procedure:

1. No tobacco products are to be used on, in department's apparatus, including responding to alarms and returning to quarters.
2. The incident commander must approve smoking and/or tobacco products on incident scenes.
3. No member under the age of 18 is to smoke or use any tobacco product while operating in the capacity of the Shelbyville Fire Department.
4. Smoking inside any of the firehouses will be prohibited at all times.
5. Spitting tobacco in trash cans and non-disposal of spit containers will be prohibited at all times.
6. Containers used for oral tobacco must have a closed sealable lid to prevent leakage or spillage.
