Purpose:

To outline the policies and rules for the Residential/Live In Firefighter Program.

Procedure:

This applies to all members who take part in the Residential/Live In Firefighter Program.

- 1. Residential/Live In firefighters must be or become a member in good standing of Shelbyville Fire & Rescue and possess a minimum of 100 hours of training. Possess and maintain a valid driver's license.
- 2. Residential /Live In firefighters must be employed fulltime, part time or be a fulltime or part time student.
- 3. Residential/Live In firefighters must meet the minimum number of training hours set forth by the Training Officer.
- 4. Residential/Live In firefighters must be willing to work a minimum of 40- hours per week; any hours over the 40-hour minimum will be reimbursed at the Duty Crew rate as long as duty crew requirements are met. *The work time will be documented on the daily log by the supervisor of that station.* The workweek will begin on Sunday and end on Saturday. The total hours will be added up by the duty officer on Sunday and forwarded to the chief's office.
- 5. Residential/Live In firefighters shall take part in the daily station details/duties and also be responsible for keeping their living area clean and tidy at all times.
- 6. Residential/Live In firefighters will be responsible for any damages that occur to Fire Department property within the living area. Such as furniture, bedding floors and walls.
- 7. Residential/Live firefighters may obtain cable or satellite television at their own expense; the Fire Chief or his designee must approve any modifications to the station.
- 8. All Residential/Live In firefighters are encouraged to obtain renters insurance to cover damage/loss of personal property. It is every Residential/Live In firefighter's duty to maintain security over their property and that of their fellow firefighters.
- 9. All Residential/Live In firefighters must be willing to submit to an initial, periodic and move out inspections. A fire officer or their designee will conduct this in their presence and the results documented.
- 10. While at the fire station the Residential/Live In firefighters shall respond to all fire/rescue calls. The Residential/Live In firefighters may "bow out" if it is one hour before they have to be at work.
